

Opportunity for Electricians

IBEW & NECA improved the organizing of electrical work and workforce by identified industry sectors. This introduces two new classifications, **Construction Wiremen** and **Construction Electricians**, to complement existing classifications of Journeyman Wiremen and Apprentices.

Construction Wiremen and **Construction Electricians** have generated new employment opportunities for Electricians that have not reached Journeyman status, not passed the California State Electrician Certification or are not enrolled in an approved apprenticeship or trainee program.

This provides a mechanism for seeking work, receiving training and opportunity to reach Journeyman status.

The National Electrical Contractors Association Chapters of San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara Valley, Northern California, Contra Costa, Redwood Empire, and Monterey Bay have joined their geographical area to form the Bay Area Region. This announcement covers the Bay Area.

All interested people with electrical experience (*including apprentices and electrical trainees*) are invited.

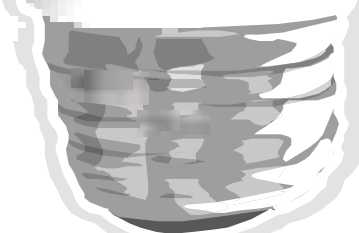
